



Stone Productions' AW139 Performance App

V3 - SP Apps System version with **Free Trial Period**

After Trial Period a Subscription is required to run this App.

In the zip-file 2 versions are distributed, one for 32-bit version and one for the 64-bit version of Excel. (in accordance with last 2 digits of filename)

Registration

To start this App, click on Activate App and let the App do its initialisation.

For first use enter Username, **Email Address** and Organisation name and click 'Check Server' button.

When your email isn't registered yet with Stone Productions, please check your email inbox to confirm your email address. Once your email address is confirmed and you click on the Check Server button again, ***your Free Trial Period will be Activated.***

After using the app save the file a least once so your registration data are saved.

Subscriptions

After the Free Trial Period you can take out a Subscription for further use of this App.

The use of this app is User/Hardware Lock based. Your profile can be reset for free a limited number of times. You need a subscription for each User/Hardware profile.

If you take out a single subscription, your subscription will be activated immediately. Only when you take out multiple subscriptions, you will be given a Subscription Code. With this code a subsequent subscription can be activated. Anyone can activate a subscription with this code after email confirmation. Keep your Subscription Code confidential and distribute it only to people that need to activate a subscription.

Known Compatibility Issues

Please note that due to the compilation to .exe, some security programs may mistake this program for malicious software. To run it you may need to make it unquarantined and put the app or directory on a white list.

Some Windows computers may not have the right configuration to allow this app to function properly. If you receive an error message on the first run with “Not all appropriate Windows Libraries are set!”, it is likely that .NET Framework 3.5 is not activated on your computer. Enter ‘windows features’ in you windows search box and activate ‘Turn Windows features on or off’ and tick the .Net Framework 3.5 box.
